3. Each entry must have a copy of the entry form entirely filled out and taped to the back of the drawing. No staples please.

Essay Contest Criteria (Very Important)

1. Essays should be 250 words in length.

3. Each essay must have a copy of the entry form entirely filled out and taped to the back of the essay.
